Eligible Students

- Student Member of S.A.R.P.
- Have not already received a bursary or scholarship from S.A.R.P.
- Enrolled in a minimum of three classes, at an eligible post-secondary institution
 - Eligible Institutions are as follows:
 - University of Saskatchewan Kinesiology
 - University of Regina Kinesiology
 - Saskatchewan Polytechnic Recreation and Tourism Management
 - Saskatchewan Polytechnic Therapeutic Recreation
 - Saskatchewan Polytechnic Sport Management

Selection Criteria

Primary factors considered in selection for all opportunities include academic performance, letters of support from faculty/employers and application submission strength. The goal for S.A.R.P. is to award all funds each year and reserve the right to adjust the criteria accordingly to ensure the funds are dispensed to qualified candidates each year.

In their first year of studies
